

Elimination of Racial Discrimination

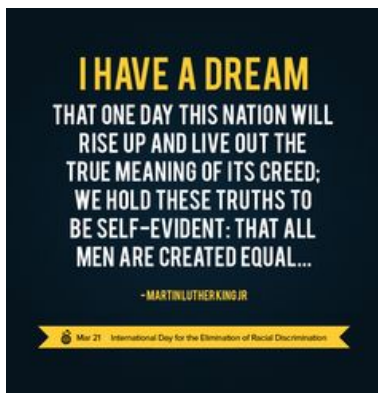
Project: Your topic is “The Elimination of Racial Discrimination”.
